Safe Summer Travel Tips

Keep your personal and financial information secure while traveling.

Summer is in full swing and with COVID restrictions being lifted, we are returning to our normal jet setting ways. As restrictions on travel lift, you should be ever more vigilant in protecting your financial and personal information.

Scammers are out in full force — from well known scam calls to sneaky links and texts. Stay vigilant with your personal cyber security protocols.

MULTIFACTOR AUTHENTICATION:

When possible, enable MFA for every account you have, financial or otherwise.

PASSWORDS:

Make sure your passwords are strong, unique, and don't repeat themselves across your accounts.

SET UP AUTOMATIC PAYMENTS FOR BILLS:

Take peace of mind on the road with you. Set your monthly payments with Online Bill Pay so you don't have to worry about missing a payment while you're away.



PUBLIC COMPUTERS:

If you ever find yourself on a public computer, try not to access your secure accounts. If you must, make sure to sign out and clear the browser history and cookies.

LET US KNOW:

Be sure to tell all your financial organization where you're traveling so we can help you keep your transactions in the clear.

CHECK EVERYTHING:

You won't know something is wrong unless you check. Check monthly statements and monitor your accounts.

THE FINANCIAL SERVICE INDUSTRY HAS NOTED AN INCREASE IN ATTEMPTS FROM SCAMMERS TO ACCESS PERSONAL ACCOUNT INFORMATION.

These attempts will often take the form of text messages, phone calls, emails, or direct messages on social media. Scammers can try convincing potential victims to provide sensitive account information by posing as a member's financial institution.

JORDAN CREDIT UNION WILL NEVER ASK FOR YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION UNLESS YOU ARE INITIATING CONTACT WITH US OR WE ARE RESPONDING TO YOUR CALL. TEXT. OR EMAIL.

Nobody wants to run into problems with their financial institution. When you receive a text alerting you that your debit card is locked due to suspicious activity, it's tempting to click the link the text provides to solve the problem—which is precisely what you shouldn't do. Cyber hackers often disguise themselves as trusted institutions like your bank or utility company to sway you into giving up your password, PIN, or other personal credentials. The message may read something like: Dear customer, Jordan Credit Union is closing your bank account. Please confirm your PIN at almostrightname.com to keep your account activated. Messages of this nature also contain urgent language such as, "If you don't reply within 24 hours, your account will be closed."

If you are ever unsure whether the person contacting you is really a representative of Jordan Credit Union, always play it safe. If you've received a suspicious email, text message, or direct message, do not respond immediately and do not click on any hyperlinks.

If you are on a suspicious phone call or have clicked a questionable link, do not provide any information. Instead, call Jordan Credit Union at (801) 566-4195 and speak to a representative with any questions or concerns you have.


