# Updates to Youth Accounts

Our IN and STAR accounts for our younger members have a new name: **YOUTH SAVINGS** and **YOUTH REWARD CHECKING**.

On January 3, 2023 all previous IN and STAR accounts will automatically update to the new name and will not result in any downtime. Just the name is changing, all the specifics of your Youth accounts will remain the same. Any automatic deposits or withdrawals will remain unchanged.

Any new Youth account opened after 9/1/22 will be named under the new style.

## YOUTH SAVINGS ACCOUNT\*

- For children ages 0-17
- Earn dividends quarterly
- No monthly or annual service fees
- Free online and mobile banking
- Receive monthly online statements
- Automatically deposit funds into or out of the accounts
- Scholarship opportunities

\*Must have parent/guardian on account. Minors age 16 and 17 may have a savings account without a parent/guardian if they have government issued ID.

- For teens ages 14-17
- Free checking with rewards!
- Can have debit card
- Free online and mobile banking
- Receive monthly online statements
- VISA credit card (Must be 17 years old)

\*\*Rewards checking available for teens 14-17. Ages 14-15 are available with a parent/guardian and 16-17 without if they have government issued ID..
